

Disabled people's transport behaviour – a secondary analysis of NTS 2024: Technical Appendix

This technical appendix includes further details on the derived variables created for the purpose of this report and the full outputs generated in the multivariable analysis.

Weighting applied¹

The National Travel Survey comes with a range of weights for different purposes. The weight used for this report was the interview sample weight. This includes all households where everybody eligible to take part in an interview participated in one. This weight included the following stages:

- The interview sample weights were calculated to correct for unequal probabilities of selection in the survey design. Each sampled address was assigned an initial weight based on its chance of being selected within the multi-stage sampling framework. This ensured that households in less frequently sampled areas were appropriately represented in the data.
- **Weighting for household participation:** The aim of the household participation weights is to attempt to reduce bias caused by systematic differences between the households that participated in NTS and those that did not. To generate the non-response weights, a logistic regression model was fitted with whether or not an eligible household participated as the outcome measure and terms associated with household participation as the covariates (region, rural-urban classification, Output Area Classification supergroups 2021 and month that address was issued).
- **Weighting for the removal of households with missing individual interviews.** The aim of these weights is to reduce the bias from the removal of households that did not have a completed individual interview for all household members. This ensured that the achieved individual sample better reflected the population profile.
- **Calibration weighting** Finally, the interview weights were calibrated to external population benchmarks. The weighted totals were aligned with mid-year population estimates by key variables, including age, sex and region. This calibration ensured that the final interview sample matched known population distributions.

Derived Variables

A number of variables were recoded for the purpose of this report and these changes are recorded below. These derived variables group answer categories from survey

Multivariable analysis

We used a combination of logistic regression and multinomial regression models to analyse the NTS 2024 data. These multivariable methods are designed to allow relationships between a number of characteristics to be analysed simultaneously and were used to explore the relationship between travel behaviour and disability status and travel behaviour and a range of impairment types, whilst taking into account demographic characteristics.

For both the logistic and multinomial models, a range of predictor variables were regressed on key outcomes. The resulting models allow us to assess the strength and nature of the relationship between each single predictor variable and the key

outcome while holding all remaining predictor variables constant. Logistic regression is used where the outcome is binary and multinomial regression is used where the key outcome had three categories.

The outcomes used in the regression models were

- Access to a car within the household (combining those who had a car in their household and were main drivers, other drivers or non-drivers vs drivers/non-drivers without a car in the household);
- Whether experienced difficulties travelling to work (yes or no);
- Whether experienced difficulties travelling for non-work reasons, such as visiting a doctor (yes or no); and
- Frequency of travel by private car, bus, train, and taxi (3 categories of at least once a week, less than once a week but more than once a year, less than once a year or never).

We ran the regression analysis in two stages. First, we modelled outcomes for the whole population, including disability status alongside with key demographic variables (gender, age, ethnicity, area type, economic activity status, household type, household income, IMD). This tested whether disability remained associated with travel outcomes once other characteristics were held constant. Second, we restricted the analysis to disabled people and replaced overall disability with individual impairment indicators (cognitive, hearing or speech, visual, mobility, mental health, other physical and other impairment). This two-stage approach avoided multicollinearity and allowed clearer interpretation of differences between impairment types. The same demographic variables were included in each model.

The tables below contain the outputs from the regression models. Results for the regression models are presented as odds ratios. These show the ratio of the odds of a specific outcome occurring when a factor is present compared to when the factor is not present. For example, if the odds of the association ratio of the association between disabled and having access to a car in the household was 0.59, it would indicate that, holding all other characteristics in the model constant, a disabled person had 41% lower odds of having access to a car in their household than a non-disabled person.
